Weekend Student Adventures (WSA) was founded by Andy Steves, son of European travel guru Rick Steves. WSA provides college students and other young travellers with guided tours of exciting European locations. They are a trusted and popular company and poised for explosive growth in the coming years.



Background

In 2013, Dactyl Studios released the first version of Weekend Student Adventures for iOS. This project was a collaborative effort between WSA and Dactyl to aggregate and organize Andy Steves' European travel insights into a mobile product that his customers could browse even if they weren't on a physical WSA tour. The app had a great user interface and a wealth of information. Upon release, it quickly became a great addition to WSA's brand exposure and a key part of Dactyl's portfolio.

Database Collaboration

One of the key challenges in maintaining WSA's iOS app on an ongoing basis, was the fact that content needed to be swapped, edited, replaced and deleted frequently. The system in place at the time was a comprehensive spreadsheet comprising all the data required. This was undoubtedly cumbersome, but there weren't any CMS platforms that satisfied the unique multimedia requirements of having text, high-resolution pictures, geographical coordinates, URLs and complex lists of daily itineraries.
